Parkside School visits - Harry Potter World

Fascinating, inspiring and spellbinding!

There are many words that could describe the Harry Potter trip, but if I had to narrow it down to three, they would be: fascinating, inspiring and spellbinding. The entrance had a wide range of famous witches and wizard's wands including Harry's and Dumbledores. The wands were massive models made of painted and highly decorated hollow fiberglass. When we arrived inside the Warner Bros studio the reception desk was sitting inside a vast, luxurious room with a ceiling that skimmed the stars. After waiting for a few minutes beside the reception desk a lady showed us to a room which was full of real and used film props including moulded masks made from a special type of putty, a professor lupin /werewolf model.

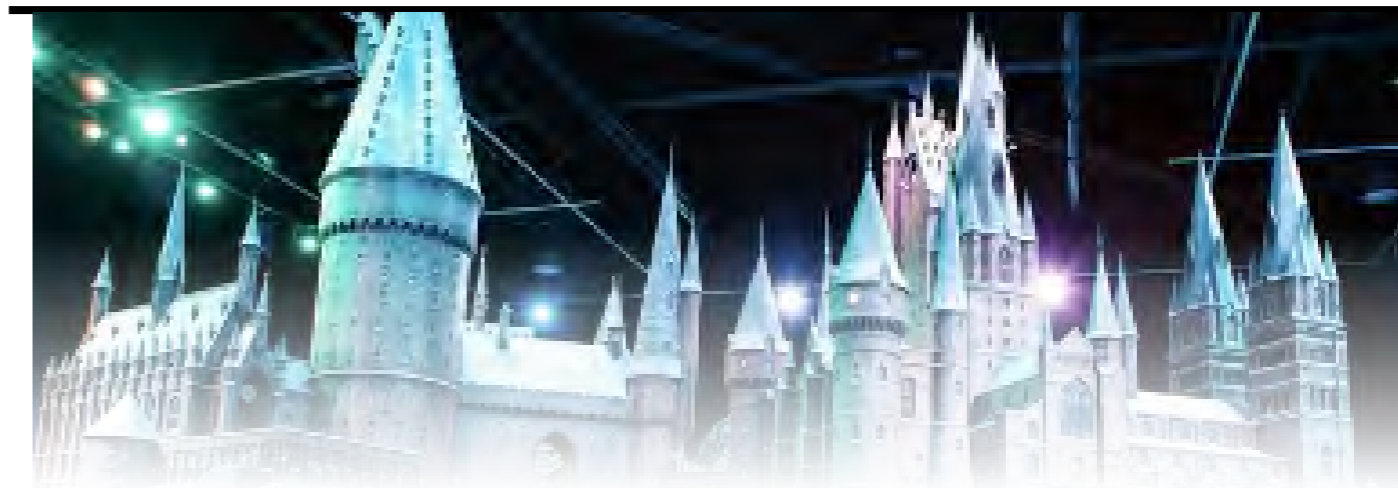
The guide gave us a task to do, she wanted us to put specific scenes

The story had been something about a crazy old war veteran that sounded like mickey mouse.

Afterwards, the entirety of year 6 went down to the lobby, which was the room following the reception

on the ground floor. The lobby had contained, the most utterly magnificent creature, a long, winding spine which had led to its tail, stretching far and meandering left and right. Its wings spreading everywhere, incredibly detailed with scars and skin, it was a beige and brown spotted ... dragon. the great hall, and then when they had finished, the screen levitated and revealed the exact same background as the screen. Even the statues outside the door were made of stone, as the tour guide opened the doors, they revealed the most magnificent model of the great hall.

The tables were set just exactly as the film had shown. When another tour guide had shown us around the hall he led us to a perfect-ed marble model of the life-size Gringotts bank. The Gift Shop, an array of fluorescent candy bars, chocolate frogs and Bertie Bott's Every Flavoured Beans, the shopping spree was outstanding. As we reluctantly edged toward the end of the tour, we ran into the lobby again, which was where we chatted about all the products, paraphernalia and treats which we had bought.
